



Important Update to your Resource[®] Plus Mastercard[®] debit card

A new service is being introduced by Mastercard and offered by 1st Source Bank that is designed to make your debit card automated payment management even simpler. As a local bank that is built upon straight talk, we at 1st Source Bank find it important to communicate the benefits of this update to you, and give you the tools you need to be able to opt out, if you so choose.

Effective October 1, 2017, all 1st Source Bank debit cards will be automatically enrolled in the Mastercard Automated Billing Updater (ABU) Service at no cost to you. When your card information is updated, such as an expiration date or card number, the ABU Service provides those updates to participating merchants who maintain your card information on file for recurring purchases/payments. Examples of this type of recurring payment include automated bill pay, subscriptions, etc. The ABU service ensures uninterrupted payments, reliable

service and convenience for 1st Source Bank debit card holders.

While this new service is free, and required by Mastercard to better serve customers and lessen the likelihood of declined payments due to outdated information, you do have the ability to opt out of the service. To opt out please complete the simple form below and mail or deliver to the bank.

To participate in this free and convenient service, simply disregard this notice.

Participation in ABU does not relieve you of the obligation to ensure that merchants have correct account information on file; failure to do so may result in a declined payment. In addition, neither Mastercard nor 1st Source Bank can guarantee that account updates are communicated to merchants prior to the next billing date. Not all merchants will participate in the ABU service.
